A favorite tradition

Celebrating the success of our business community at the Annual Chamber Awards Banquet each year has become one of my favorite annual traditions. So many tremendous strides have been made this past year that will undoubtedly impact the quality of life for Hays and Ellis County residents for decades to come.

When I interviewed for this position almost five years ago, I referred to Hays as a sleeping giant. I think it is safe to say that giant is now awake!

In 2023, we peaked our membership at new heights with 540 members. With that support, our organization offered over 250 opportunities for businesses, organizations, and the community to engage with:

- 92 Ambassador, Board, and Hays Young Professional events and offerings
- 41 Chamber Chats that illuminated current members
- 35 Ribbon Cuttings, some joint Brick Presentations, to welcome new businesses and commemorate significant milestones
- 33 professional development opportunities geared toward strengthening our workforce, fostering leadership growth, and

connecting employers and employees alike with valuable resources and local programs

• A wide array of advocacy efforts, including the facilitation of the Child Care Task Force of Ellis County, Western Kansas Delegation advocacy trip in Washington D.C., Legislative Coffees, a Fall Election Forum, and writing numerous letters of support for the R9 Water Ranch, Hays Regional Airport, FHSU, and other member businesses.

Similarly, our chamber helped introduce an additional \$67,000 worth of commerce into our community through the Chamber Cheque program, as we continued to champion the need to shop local throughout the year.

In 2024, The Chamber will continue its diligent focus in the following areas:

- Enhancing access for leadership opportunities for our members through the 2024 Leadership Transformation Grant from the Kansas Leadership Center, which will afford 56 individuals to attend training in Wichita, Kansas

- Broadening access to Chamber Blue of Kansas for more affordable healthcare options for employers
- Building the reach of Leadership Hays, Dale Carnegie, and Igniting Leadership to heighten the importance of civic leadership in our community
- Providing quality training opportunities for chamber staff to ensure they are strongly positioned to collaborate with our business community to continue providing progress for the city and county

# Ellis County Historical Society signs lease on Victoria satellite site



After nearly  $2\frac{1}{2}$  years of negotiation, Ellis County Historical Society Executive Director Amanda Rupp and Victoria Community Coalition Board Chairman

Jeff Pfeifer signed a lease agreement that will allow construction to begin on a satellite site for ECHS. The space will be located in St. John's Place, the former Victoria Nursing Home, which will soon be renovated to house 12 senior living apartments and a community area. The next phase will include an area to accommodate childcare.

"It is a dream come true," stated Mary Kay Schippers, Chair of the Renovations Committee. Part of the space will be used for exhibits and the rest for storage.

The Society's plan is to be open by 2026, which will be in time to celebrate the sesquicentennial of the Volga Germans settling in Ellis County.

While the Society's Hays museum focuses primarily on the history of Hays, the Victoria location will direct its focus on the outlying area of Ellis County and the immigrants who settled there.




